What will we be learning at Edcamp Branford?

That depends upon the participants when they arrive. There is a schedule but no agenda. The agenda will be set by combining the topics people wish to learn about and the topics people wish to share about.

How much does it cost?

Edcamp Branford is a free event. Other than providing your own travel and lunch there is no additional cost.
